VD = Vaginal delivery; CD = Cesarean delivery

- **Mobility:** *Able to rise from a standing squat
- ** If adult supervision is available for 24 hours

Maternal support:

- **Low: Non-acute conditions but requiring continued hospitalization** (e.g. observation after complicated vaginal delivery)
- **Moderate: Ongoing acute conditions requiring continued hospitalization and intermittent IV fluid/medications** (e.g. chorioamnionitis requiring IV antibiotics, hypertension off magnesium, blood transfusion)
- **High: Medically high- risk requiring transport by RN/MD and/or continuous IV medication infusion** (e.g. preeclampsia with severe features on magnesium, insulin dependent diabetes on IV insulin)
